He graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School and after attending Camden County College he pursued the studies of Dialysis Technician and HVAC Technician. Miguel is currently a Medicare and HIPAA compliance officer. He is passionate about his community and educates throughout the city by way of local health fairs and through the coordination of other services. Miguel was an active Member of the Board of Directors of Puerto Rican Unity For Progress (one of the oldest nonprofit organizations in the city), and had served as President of the Board for four years. He was a member of the Executive Board Student Leader Task Force, Camden City Youth, Jeff Boxing Club, Miguel Figueroa Gym, Philadelphia Panorama Latin Youth, the Hispanic Chamber of Commerce of Philadelphia, and the Mexican Chamber of Commerce. He also founded Miguel's Pharmacy in the very city where he was raised. Driven by a deep commitment to his community, Miguel aimed to do more than provide healthcare, he wanted to create lasting opportunities. Inspired by his own journey, he established a scholarship fund to support Camden youth pursuing higher education. Through this initiative, Miguel hopes to empower the next generation and invest in the future of the city that shaped him.

- Must be a Camden city resident. Proof of Address will be required
- Applicant must be of Hispanic heritage
- 3.0 or higher GPA
- One Reference. Please provide one letter of recommendation. Professional and academic references preferred, but not required. References cannot be friends or family.
- Essay must be 500 words

Deadline

Application must be submitted by **July 13, 2025** to <u>jennifer@movitricolor.org</u>. Late applications will not be accepted. A formal letter of acceptance will be sent via email to the scholarship winner by **July 31, 2025**. The recipient is expected to show enrollment for the Fall 2025 semester before scholarship funds will be provided. The recipient is expected to be available **August 17, 2025 in Camden, NJ** at the **Wiggins Park Marina**, 1 Riverside Dr, Camden, NJ 08103 for presentation of the scholarship award at the **First Dominican Restoration Day Parade**.
